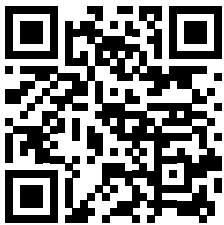

Attn: Indiana Contractors

The Indiana Office of Energy Development (OED) is preparing to launch the Indiana Energy Saver Program. Nearly \$182 million from the U.S. Department of Energy was allocated to the State of Indiana to assist residents in reducing energy costs through energy efficiency improvements and appliance upgrades through the Home Efficiency Rebate (HOMES) and Home Appliance Rebate (HEAR) programs.

Programs Available

The funding comes from two federal programs:

Home Efficiency Rebate (HOMES)

- Focuses on whole-home retrofits to achieve at least 20% predicted energy savings
- Applicable to both single-family and multi-family residential homes
- Available to all Hoosiers
- Eligible upgrades include ENERGY STAR-certified heating and cooling, ENERGY STAR-certified water heaters, insulation, air sealing, duct sealing, appliances and lighting

Home Appliance Rebate (HEAR)

- Focuses on energy efficient appliances and equipment
- Tailored specifically for low- and moderate-income households (earning less than 150% of Area Median Income)
- Applicable to both single- family and multi-family homes
- Eligible appliance and equipment upgrades include heat pump water heaters, heat pump HVAC systems, electric stoves, heat pump clothes dryers, and crucial electrical system enhancements such as service load centers/panels and electrical wiring

Contractor Benefits

Contractors that participate in the Qualified Contractor Network for the Indiana Energy Saver Program can receive the following benefits:

- A steady stream of assignments/referrals from the program without needing to conduct prior outreach or to complete significant paperwork.
- Prompt payment of eligible incentives upon approval of project completion.
- The opportunity to help the Hoosiers cut energy costs and put more money back in Hoosiers' pockets;
 - Be recognized as an Indiana Energy Saver Program qualified contractor;
 - Expand your geographic reach and customer base;
 - Contribute to future program development by providing insights and feedback;
 - Gain valuable experience and technical support with federal programs and compliance.

How to Get Started

Contractors interested in providing services for the Indiana Energy Saver Program must first be vetted and approved to join the network. Qualified contractors are expected to possess the proper equipment, knowledge, and customer service skills necessary to deliver high quality service. To start the process:
